### **Things Parents Should Know!**

**KIDZ ZONE MISSION:** We love kids, we laugh together, we play together, we teach God's word, and we discuss God's word.

**KIDZ ZONE TIME:** Sundays starting at 9:00 am.

**CURRICULUM:** The lesson plans will be Christ-centered, Bible-based teaching that is relevant to practical living. Our curriculum will empower children to become leaders and make an impact in every aspect of their lives.

**Instructors & Junior Instructors:** Children Ministry is a dynamic team effort. It takes the efforts and dedication of many people, members, parents, and workers, to carry out this ministry! We are here to work alongside the parents in their biblical teaching and encouragement of their children. We desire to see the children of Father's House rise

and take their places in our congregation and the world as bearers of the Good News of Jesus Christ.

We have adult instructors over the age of 21 and Junior instructors ages 15- 20. All our adult instructors are First Aid and CPR certified. Our classes are divided into three age groups: ~~2-4~~, 5-7, and 8-10.

#### **CHECK-IN & OUT PROCEDURES:**

- 1) A Kidz Zone greeter will meet the parents and children in the hallway, near the Kidz Zone area.
- 2) Check-in: Sign your child in on the Sign-in sheet or tablet. \*It is also helpful to communicate any instructions verbally to the greeter.
- 3) Check-Out: Parents are asked to pick up their child(ren) immediately following the service.
- 4) Children must be picked up within 5 minutes following dismissal.

\*Please do not send relatives or siblings to pick up children, unless they have already been designated to do so. **(Relatives or siblings under 16 years old are not allowed to sign out children.)**

#### **Health Policies**

- 1) For the protection of your child(ren) and other children, parents are asked not to bring any child who appears to be ill.
- 2) We do not administer any medication.

#### **Behavior and Discipline:**

The safety of all children will be maintained. No throwing, biting, kicking, pushing, or hitting will be allowed. When a behavior problem occurs, the child will be redirected to a more appropriate behavior. The appropriate behavior will be modeled for the child(ren). Older children may be asked to apologize to the other child if the circumstance calls for reconciliation. If the above procedures are ineffective, the parents will be asked to report to the Kidz Zone area.

#### **Food Policies**

A small snack will be provided in Kidz Zone. Please see the list of snack items that may be served: chips, cookies, fruit cups, gummy bears, fruits, crackers, and juice.

#### **Emergency Procedures**

In case of an evacuation, instructors will take the children to the nearest safe exit.

Emergency First Aid kits are located in the Children Ministry's room and will be used for minor accidents. The Ministry Leader will be paged and parents will be notified in the event of an emergency.

If a child becomes seriously ill or injured, the Instructor or the Director will immediately contact the Medical Response Team.
